

PURCHASE ORDER ATTACHMENT P-59A (00)

DOME

PART NAME: Dome

PART NUMBER: 260072-1, 3829700-1

UNIT PACKAGE QUANTITY: One part per unit container.

CUSHIONING: Flexible foam, plastic open or closed cell material or equivalent. Do not use shredded paper.

UNIT CONTAINER: See packaging/packing methods.

SHIPPING CONTAINER: Corrugated fiberboard box, RSC, domestic, of sufficient quality and strength to insure safe arrival of parts.

PACKAGING/PACKING METHOD (preferred): Wrap the dome in neutral tissue paper and place into a snug fitting cavity of molded polystyrene foam cushioning material. If necessary, wrap the dome in cushioning to assure a snug fit into the cavity. Place the cushioned dome into a unit container which is a corrugated fiberboard box, RSC, domestic of sufficient quality and strength to assure safe arrival of parts. Pack any number of unit containers into a shipping container. Fill voids with cushioning or empty unit containers. Do not exceed the weight limitation of the container.

PACKAGING/PACKING METHOD (optional): Package one part into the unit container (molded plastic box) and tape close. Place one unit container into a cushioned intermediate container, which is a corrugated fiberboard box, RSC, domestic of sufficient quality and strength to assure safe arrival of parts. Cushioning shall be a minimum of 1/2 inch thick around the entire unit container and hold the unit container snugly in place. Pack any number of intermediate containers into a shipping container. Fill voids with cushioning or empty intermediate containers, do not exceed the weight limitations of the container.
NOTE: When using optional packaging/packing method RMSC written approval is required prior to the first shipment of each purchase order.

MARKING INSTRUCTIONS: Mark the unit and intermediate containers with RMSC part name/number and quantity. Mark the shipping container with RMSC part name/number, quantity and purchase order number. Place "fragile" labels on the shipping container.

PALLETIZATION: If required, palletize with any standard pallet such that a stable, unitized, and stackable load is created. Fibreboard (cardboard) pallets with plastic cup feet are not allowed.

NOTE: To preserve the environment, RMSC recommends that packaging materials which are manufactured from, and or, with CFC's (chloroflorocarbons) not be used.
