

## PURCHASE ORDER ATTACHMENT TC-007

### Optional FAR/DFARS Clauses

The following Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Clauses and Department of Defense Supplement Clauses (DFARS) are added to and made a part of the Purchase Order General Provisions effective for this Purchase Order.

**ONLY THOSE CLAUSES CITED ON THE FACE OF OR IN THE TEXT OF THIS ORDER ARE INCORPORATED BY THIS REFERENCE.**

<u>FAR/DFARS REFERENCES</u>	<u>TITLE</u>
A. 52.215-15	<b>Pension Adjustments and Asset Reversions.</b> “Contracting Officer” shall mean Buyer.
B. 52.215-18	<b>Reversion or Adjustment of Plans for Postretirement Benefits Other than Pensions (PRB).</b> “Contracting Officer” shall mean Buyer.
C. 52.229-4	<b>Federal, State, and Local Taxes (Non-competitive Contract).</b> “Government” means Buyer except in the definition of “Excepted Tax,” and “Contracting Officer” means Buyer’s Purchasing Representative. FAR 52.229-3 is hereby deleted from Purchase Order General Provisions.
D. 52.230-2	<b>Cost Accounting Standards.</b> FAR 52.230-2, as cited and amended in the “Additional Provisions” section of Raytheon Attachment TC-002, is hereby incorporated by reference into this Purchase Order.
E. 52.230-3	<b>Disclosure and Consistency of Cost Accounting Practices.</b> FAR 52.230-3, as cited and amended in the “Additional Provisions” section of Raytheon Attachment TC-002, is hereby incorporated by reference into this Purchase Order.
F. 52.230-5	<b>Cost Accounting Standards – Educational Institutions.</b> FAR 52.230-5, as cited and amended in the “Additional Provisions” section of Raytheon Attachment TC-002, is hereby incorporated by reference into this Purchase Order.
G. 52.230-6	<b>Administration of Cost Accounting Standards.</b> FAR 52.230, as cited and amended in the “Additional Provisions” section of Raytheon Attachment TC-002, is hereby incorporated by reference into this Purchase Order.
H. 52.232-16	<b>Progress Payments.</b> Buyer’s contract provides for progress payments in accordance with the cited FAR provision. A request for progress payments will not be considered as a handicap or adverse factor in the award of Purchase Order. Seller certifies that if awarded progress payments, it has an accounting system, which will adequately accumulate costs and accommodate progress payments. All invoicing by Seller shall be on a properly completed and submitted SF1443. All references to “Contracting Officer” and “Government” shall mean Buyer in all instances within the clause except in section (a)(l)(i), and in those subparagraphs involving vesting of title and risk of loss.
I. 52.232-16	<b>Progress Payments (Small Business) (Alternate 1).</b> Buyer’s contract provides for progress payments in accordance with the cited FAR provision. A request for progress payments will not be considered as a handicap or adverse factor in the award of Purchase Order. Seller certifies that if awarded progress payments, it has an accounting system, which will adequately accumulate costs and accommodate progress payments. All invoicing by Seller shall be on a properly completed and submitted SF1443. All references to “Contracting Officer” and “Government” shall mean Buyer in all instances within the clause except in section (a)(l)(i), and in those subparagraphs involving vesting of title and risk of loss.
